

The Antarctic ice sheet






The white continent

- → The largest ice sheet : 14 Mkm² (~ 60 times the UK)
- → Also the oldest : 40 Myrs
- And the coldest : down to -90°C
- Highest point: 4,900 m (up to 4,750m of ice)



The Greenland ice sheet





The world's largest island

- → Surface : 1.7 Mkm² (~7 times the UK)
- → Age : ~20 Myrs
- Coldest temperature : -70°C
- Highest point : 3,300 m (up to 3,000 m of ice)









NO! These periods are called interglacials. Example : Pangea (300-150 Myrs)



Have the ice sheets been larger?




Yes! During glacial periods also called **Glaciations** or **Ice Ages**.






